WHAT MAKES THE SABIAN SOUND?

THE PROFILE

As the actual of the cymbal becomes higher towards the bell, the pitch of the cymbal becomes higher with increased brightness in tone.

THE BELL

A larger bell will generally produce more rich overtones resulting in a longer sustain. A smaller bell will result in a guicker speaking sound from the cymbal.

THE WEIGHT

A heavier cymbal will produce more volume, increased ring, and a slightly slower response. A lighter cymbal will produce less volume, generate a quicker response, and have a faster decay

THE LATHING

The AA & HH models are crafted with a traditional lathing process resulting in a thicker ridge to creat a broad, singing tone. The AAX, HHX, & Artisan is crafted with a pinpoint lathing process which relieves tension allowing it to respond faster and sound more modern.

THE HAMMERING

Hand hammering creates a cymbal that can be individually shaped to be warmer and darker in tone. The actual size of the hammering affects how the sound waves travel through and around the cymbal.

LETS TALK CYMBALS

ATTACK

The initial sound heard from striking. Small, thin cymbals have a fast attack whereas larger, thicker cymbals have a slower attack.

BRIGHTNESS

When a cymbal possesses a large percentage of high partials. Thick and or heavy cymbals are usually bright.

CUT

When a cymbal can be clearly heard through an ensemble. Brighter cymbals produce more volume allowing the cymbal to "Cut" through the ensemble.

DRY

A dry cymbal does not produce a long sustaining sound and tends to have more clarity when played with a stick. A dry cymbal has more clarity and definition.

FAST

A fast cymbal responds rapidly and has a shorter sustain.

FUNDAMENTAL

The dominate pitch of any cymbal. you want your cymbals to have prominent partials more than the fundamental so that it does not interfere with the tonalities in an ensemble setting.

TRASHY

A raw and biting response of a cymbal. Very open and has the characteristics of a Chinese cymbal.

SUSTAIN

The length of time it takes for a cymbal to stop vibrating. The duration of sound a cymbal produces.

TIMBRE

The general sound characteristics of a cymbal.

DARK

When a cymbal produces a large percentage of low partials. Thin and or light cymbals are typically dark in sound.

PARTIALS

Overtones or a series of pitches that are produced in addition to the fundamental. Every Cymbal will have a unique percentage of highs, lows, and mid range partials.

WARM

A warm cymbal blends more with an ensemble. Cymbals that are dark and or posses mostly low and mid range partials will general be thought of as warm.

CYMBAL GRIPS

THE CONCERT GRIP



STEP 1

The palm is placed over the strap with the strap forming a line from the second joint of the index finger to the first joint of the pinky finger



STEP 2

Curl the fingers around the strap.

THE MARCHING GRIP



STEP 1

Hold the cymbal in a vertical position and put the hand through the strap up to the wrist.



STEP 2

Rotate the a 1/4 turn so that the thumb is pointing towards the cymbal.



STEP 3

The thumb is placed against the strap. The feel should be similar to that of holding a drumstick.



STEP 3

Rotate the hand back a 1/4 turn until it is touching the bell and the strap is positioned between the thumb and the index finger.

HAND CYMBAL TECHNIQUE

THE BASIC CRASH

There are multiple ways to play hand cymbals in order to create a well produced sound. The important aspect is to maintain a similar motion in both hands. Also remember that the point of contact when making a proper cymbal crash is to strike each plate off center by approximately 3/4". This will greatly reduce the risk of producing a "popping" sound.



STEP 1

Hold the cymbals together near the chest at a slight angle.



STEP 3

Drop the top cymbal onto the bottom, while gently tossing up the bottom cymbal.Either hand may be on top. Allow gravity to do the work for you.



STEP 2

Hold the cymbals slightly apart in preparation for the crash.



STEP 4

After the initial sound, pull the cymbals apart in the direction from which they come.

TYING CYBMAL STRAPS

Hand cymbals should be equipped with SABIAN leather straps or the SABIAN heavy duty nylon straps.





Pull both ends of the straps through the cymbals



STEP 2

Lay each strap tab down with rough side up.





STEP 5

Take the last horizontal strap and feed through the last vertical tail loop.





See pic below as you have just created a square knot.



STEP 3

Take opposite tails and fold towards each other vertically





Take one horizontal strap and fold and loop through one of the vertical tail loops.



Pull each tail evenly to tighten the knot and secure in place.

HOW DID WE DO IT?

The first harmonic on a crotale disc is extremely important and we worked with tuners from all over the world to develop a system that will allow us to produce an overtone that is a full octave above the fundamental.

OTHER BRANDS

The other brands have left this harmonic un-tuned and the result is the harmonic you hear is a minor 9th. Not in tune and not setting up the rest of the octave to speak clearly.
